Join Marshfield Clinic Health System Recovery Corps!

Recovery Corps is seeking 20 full-time AmeriCorps members to undergo comprehensive training in the Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery (CCAR) model of recovery coaching and will focus on reducing prescription drug, opioid, and other substance use disorders through one-on-one contact, outreach phone calls, and community education in the northern Wisconsin region served by the HOPE Consortium (Forest, Iron, Oneida, Price, and Vilas Counties and Forest County Potawatomi, Lac du Flambeau, and Sokaogon Chippewa Tribal Nations).

Term of Service:

September 11, 2017 - August 31, 2018 (end date is negotiable)

Benefits:

- Receive \$485.77 (gross before taxes) bi-weekly payroll for term of service
- Enroll in health insurance - with premium paid in full for member only
- Receive childcare assistance (if qualified)
- Earn a \$5,815 education award upon successful completion of the term of service
- Enter forbearance on qualified student loans and interest accrual payments while serving (taxable)
- Gain valuable work experience and develop highly sought job skills (initiative, interpersonal and intercultural communication, adaptability, collaboration, and accountability)
- Network for career placement
- Build value - in yourself and the position you serve

Required Orientation & Training (expenses covered):

- AmeriCorps Member Orientation - September 11 - 15, 2017
- CCAR Training - October 2-6, 2017
- AmeriCorps Mid-Term Training - January 3-5, 2017

Applying to be a Member

Applicants must be willing to serve for the duration of the term of service (1,700 hours minimum), averaging approximately 35-40 hours a week. Members must also be able to handle the financial commitment made by accepting the position. Applicants must be 19 years of age by September 11, 2017; have at least one year of lived, direct or indirect experience with recovery from a substance use disorder; possess a high school diploma or GED/HSED; and agree to and pass a criminal and Department of Motor Vehicles background checks.
