Size: Up to 10 beds with sleeping capacity of 13

Persons Eligible: Up to 4 Men / Up to 4 Women / 1 Family (if room available). Not handicap accessible.

Length of Stay: 30 – 90 days as long as compliant

Conditions for Admission:

Intake/background check/drug screen/breathalyzer. Can take medication assisted treatment (MAT) as prescribed by physician and compliant with AODA treatment plan.

If Admitted:

Assigned case manager to assist in accessing community/state resources, random drug screens weekly, will contact Freedom Vans to drive reasonable distances to therapy appointments (with appropriate notice).

Persons Eligible: Men / Women / Families

Length of Stay: 30 - 90 days as long as compliant

Conditions for Admission:

Intake/background check/drug screen/breathalyzer, and no history of felonies. MAT cases need director approval.

If Admitted:

Assigned case manager who meets with client on as needed basis, will provide transportation to therapy appointments and AA/NA meetings, all mental health clients are encouraged to take medications as prescribed.

Size: Up to 16 beds (first come, first serve basis)

Persons Eligible: Men/Women/Families (children must attend school). Men and women must be 18 years or older. Must be homeless in accordance with state and federal definitions of homelessness. Only one admission in a 12 month period is permitted.

Length of Stay: 30 days in shelter if following house rules and working on goals (can be granted additional 30 day increments as needed). Maximum stay for individual or family is 90 days.

Conditions for Admission:

Intake/drug screen/breathalyzer. Must pass background check and have no history of violent crimes within past 5 years (domestic violence or battery); no admission granted if registered on state and federal sex offenders list.

Can take medication assisted treatment (MAT) as prescribed by physician and compliant with AODA treatment plan.

If Admitted:

Assigned a case manager to establish goals and aid in accessing community, county, and state resources. Will attempt to arrange transportation to therapy appointments (with advance notice).

Length of Stay: No limit as long as working toward goals developed with the shelter counselor; evaluated every 15 days **Conditions for Admission:**

Intake/background check/12 panel drug screen. Can take suboxone (MAT) as prescribed by physician and compliant with AODA treatment plan.

If Admitted:

Will have 15 day goal setting with counselor, will provide transportation to therapy appointments (with reasonable notice).
