What is a PDMP?

Pharmacies and other dispensers of monitored prescription drugs submit data

Data is added to a statewide database

1) Authorized users access PDMP data to verify prescription information



WI ePDMP

- Enhanced system launched January 2017
- Over 2,000 dispenser submitters
- Over 46,000 healthcare users
- Data for controlled substances in schedule II-V dispensed in Wisconsin
- Over 9 million records submitted each year


2015 Act
266
Effective April

2017

- Dispensers required to submit to the PDMP by the end of the next business day (previously 7 days)
- Prescribers required to review PDMP prior to prescribing a monitored prescription drug
- Expanded access to PDMP

Daily Patient Queries


December 2016: 4,800 queries August 20, 2018: 32,800 queries

January 2017: 101,000 queries October 2018: 641,400 queries





H.O.P.E. Agenda Legislation

Law Enforcement Act 266 (effective April 2017):
 Law enforcement and prosecutorial units allowed to request PDMP data without a court order

 Act 268 (effective March 2016): Law enforcement agencies shall report to the PDMP information about specific events

The PDMP shall disseminate the information from law enforcement agencies to relevant PDMP users



Law Enforcement PDMP Access

Request for PDMP Report

- Released after review and approval by DSPS staff (2 – 3 business days)
- Records about schedule II-V controlled substance prescriptions dispensed in Wisconsin
- Information should correspond to original records kept by prescribers and dispensers
- Potentially useful information to help guide investigations of drug diversion or overdose
- Not "evidence" and should not be used in isolation to make any determinations about a patient, prescriber, or dispenser




Investigative Tool

- WI ePDMP is a compilation of data submitted to it by dispensers, and <u>information in the</u> <u>PDMP should correspond to original records</u> <u>kept by prescribers and dispensers</u>.





Data Driven Alerts

WI ePDMP uses sophisticated data analytics to assess a patient's controlled substance prescription history

- 1. Multiple Prescribers or Pharmacies

 5 or more in the last 90 days
- 2. High Current Daily Dose of Opioids

 Exceeds 90 morphine milligram equivalent (MME)
- 3. Concurrent Benzodiazepine and Opioid *Active prescriptions for both drugs*
- 4. Long-Term Opioid Therapy with Multiple Prescribers

1 opioid or more from 2 or more prescribers for more than 90 days


- 5. Multiple Same Day Prescriptions

 Same controlled substance drug from multiple prescribers or pharmacies on the same day
- 6. Early Refill

 Filled 2 or more days earlier than expected

Dispensing Data Inclusions/Exclusions

The WI ePDMP is not a comprehensive prescription drug database

It does includes:

- Controlled substances in Schedules II-V
- Dispensing Practitioners
- Veterinary dispensings filled by a pharmacy
- Mail order pharmacy dispensings
- Veterans Affairs pharmacies in WI

It Excludes

- Monitored drugs administered directly to a patient
- Monitored drugs dispensed at veterinarian clinic
- Dispensing by federally funded opioid treatment programs
- Diagnosis code



Accessing Bordering State PDMPs

WI Healthcare Prescribers can access PDMP data from boarding states within the WI PDMP.

Access to Other
State PDMPs

Law Enforcement must contact the individual states to request PDMP access. It is not allowable for the WI PDMP to display interstate data to law enforcement users.



Law Enforcement Alerts



Duty to Report

- Suspected Violation of Controlled Substances Act
- Suspected Narcotic Related Death
- Suspected Opioid Related Overdose (Non-Fatal)
- Report of Stolen Controlled Substance Prescription



Law Enforcement User

Who should have a PDMP account at your agency?

- Internal Law enforcement agency decision on process for PDMP user accounts
 - Administrative role
 - Individual officers
 - Other
- Accounts are based on individual user name
 - Export log of Alert History
 - Export Patient Report



Determining When to Report

Only events involving a monitored prescription drug

Suspected Violation of the Controlled Substances Act Involving a Prescription Drug

Report of Stolen Controlled Substance Prescription

Events involving both prescription and non-prescription opioid controlled substances

Suspected Fatal Narcotic Overdose

Suspected Non-Fatal Opioid-Related Drug Overdose






Welcome to the Wisconsin Enhanced Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Statistics Dashboard

(Based on Date of Submission)




Dispensing Trends

2015-2018 Trend by Drug Class

Opioids: 29% decrease (1.5 million fewer prescriptions)


Benzodiazepines: 19% decrease (445,000 fewer prescriptions)


Stimulants: 6% increase (in 2016, then minimal change)
