



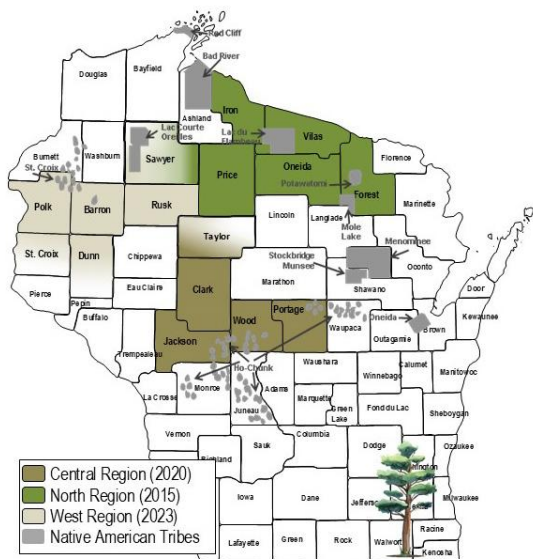
## Risk Reduction Resource Guide

Updated 5/14/2026

Risk reduction incorporates practical strategies for reducing the risk of negative consequences associated with different activities, including substance use. Examples of common risk reduction practices include the use of sunscreen when spending time outdoors to reduce the risk of sunburn and wearing a helmet while riding a bike to reduce the risk of brain injury.

This guide lists substance use risk reduction services available throughout the HOPE Consortium service area by county. Risk reduction services listed include:

- **Naloxone Boxes:** Contain free doses of the opioid overdose reversal medication naloxone and use instructions. You may have also heard these boxes called other names such as O.A.K. (overdose aid kits) or Nalox-ZONE™. A complete listing of boxes installed by Wisconsin Voices for Recovery across the state can be found [here](#).
- **Naloxone Direct Programs:** Provide free doses of the opioid overdose reversal medication naloxone and training in its use as well as fentanyl and xylazine test strips. A complete listing of agencies participating in the Wisconsin Naloxone Direct Program can be found [here](#).
- **Public Health Vending Machines:** Like a classic vending machine, but stocked with items that support public health, such as naloxone, personal hygiene items, wound care supplies, gun locks, and more. Supplies vary.
- **Syringe Service Programs (SSP):** Provide sterile syringes and other supplies to help individuals who inject drugs reduce the risk of communicable diseases like HIV and hepatitis C. Many SSPs are hosted in partnership with Vivent Health and local health departments.
- **Other Supply Distribution Channels:** Risk reduction supplies are also distributed by various community agencies as noted. Vivent Health makes certain risk reduction items available for free by mail to Wisconsin residents. Requests can be placed online at <https://depot.viventhealth.org/product-category/state/wisconsin>. Select supplies are available only to residents of Wood County and Milwaukee.
